



Dear Parishioner

On Saturday the 4th June, the Parish is celebrating the Queen's Platinum Jubilee with an all-day event.

It is a family event with a range of attractions as well as a big screen on the village green to allow people to follow the celebrations in London and watch the evening concert which starts at 8pm.

For safety reasons, we have taken the decision to make some temporary car parking and traffic flow arrangements and I am writing to you now, as you live on the affected roads, to give you advance notice of these as follows:

Parking - Friday, 3rd June from 4.00 p.m. until Midnight on Saturday, 4th June:

- Parish Hall car park will be closed
- Shoppers' car park will be closed (shops can be accessed by foot from designated temporary parking areas)
- No on-road parking on Rue des Marettes as this will become one way to allow buses and other vehicles to exit onto Rue de la Croix. **Temporary parking will be provided on the community field on Rue de la Croix.**

Road Closures: On Saturday 4th June, the following roads will be closed from 9 a.m. 'till midnight:

- The main road into St Ouens Village Northbound will be closed at St Ouen's Motorworks, with diversions signposted at the Junction of Rue de la Pointe. There will however be access to Waitrose and St Ouen's Motorworks.
- The main road into St Ouens Village Southbound will be closed at the Junction of La Route de Trodez, Rue de la Croix and Route de Vinchelez. Diversions will be in place to St. Mary and St. Peter via Rue de la Croix.
- Rue de la Forge will be closed Westbound at the junction of Rue des Marettes. Diversions will be in place.
- Route du Marais will be closed at the junction of La Cache de L'Eglise Eastbound with access to shops and other premises by foot, from designated temporary parking areas.

One-way roads: On Saturday 4th June, the following roads will all be one-way from 9.00 a.m. 'till midnight:

- La Rue des Nouettes
- Rue des Grantez from the La Rue des Nouettes junction until it joins with La Ville de l'Eglise
- La Rue de la Croute
- La Rue des Marettes

The Parish is aware of the impact these changes will have on parishioners living near the surrounding area and will do all it can to minimise disruption. In order to be helpful, a map is enclosed showing the proposed diversions and how they might affect you. Diversions will be in place and temporary parking for those living within the event area will be provided.

If you are intending to use your car on 4th June, and you are located on any of the closed roads, you should move your car to the temporary carpark on the Community field along Rue de la Croix before 9am on the 4th.

I would like to thank you in advance for your understanding and co-operation. I want our Parish community of all ages to enjoy a memorable and safe day which is why we have taken the above measures.
