- Metal packaging: black box/bin with blacksticker

Paper & card Your blue box or labelled bin

- √ Yes please
- ✓ Magazines
- √ Comics
- ✓ Catalogues
- ✓ Envelopes
- ✓ Newspapers
- ✓ Cardboard packaging and boxes - cut up large pieces of card
- √ Shredded paper - recommended for confidential papers
- ✓ Greeting cards
- X No thank you
- X Milk or drink cartons
- Polystyrene or plastics

Your glass bin You are required to provide your own bin for glass

- √ Yes please
- ✓ Glass bottles
- ✓ Glass jars
- ✓ Broken glass
- > Please rinse
- > Remove corks, caps or lids
- > Remove plastic labels (paper labels can be left on)
- X No thank you
- Plastic bags
- Lightbulbs*
- Ceramics (cups, mugs, plates,etc.)*
- X Electrical/ electronic goods*
- Cardboard
- ★ General rubbish
