**AT AN ASSEMBLY** of Electors of the Parish of St. Ouen, duly convened and held in St. Ouen's Parish Hall on Wednesday, 14 August, 2024 at 7.10p.m. pursuant to an Act of the Royal Court dated 19 July, 2024, whereby it was ordered that an election be held for Centenier in the Parish of St. Ouen.

The Assembly having lasted the statutory time and there being no further nominations the President declared Mrs Jo-Anne Maree Grundy duly elected as Centenier.
