This guide explains how to use the St. Ouen household recycling collection. A collection planner is included so you know when your recycling will be collected.

Every home in St. Ouen receives a recycling collection, in addition to the existing rubbish and glass collections. Recycling collections will be on the same day as your refuse.

- **Plastic bottles:** red box/bin with red sticker
- **Metal packaging:** black box/bin with black sticker

Everything we collect for recycling is sent for recycling and the parish of St. Ouen is making it even easier for you to reduce your waste and recycle more.
