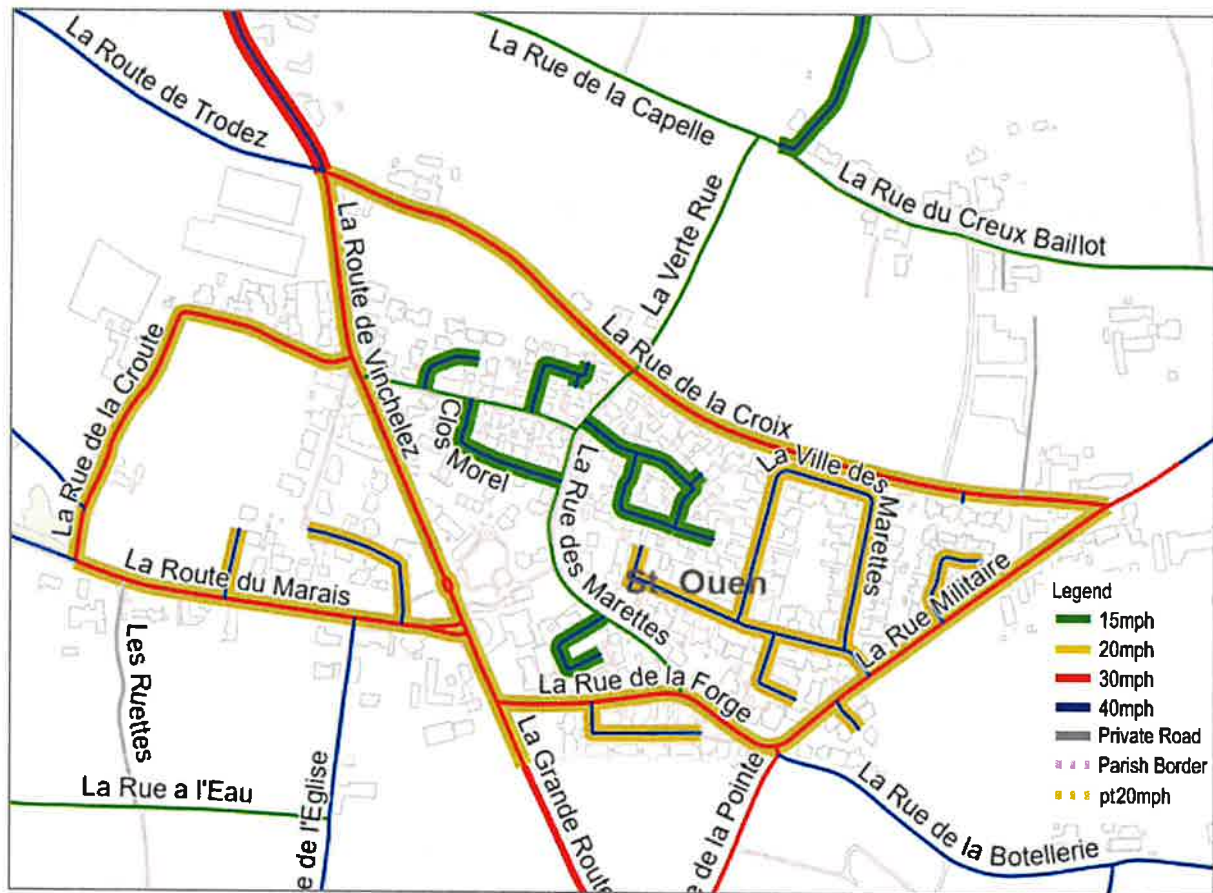

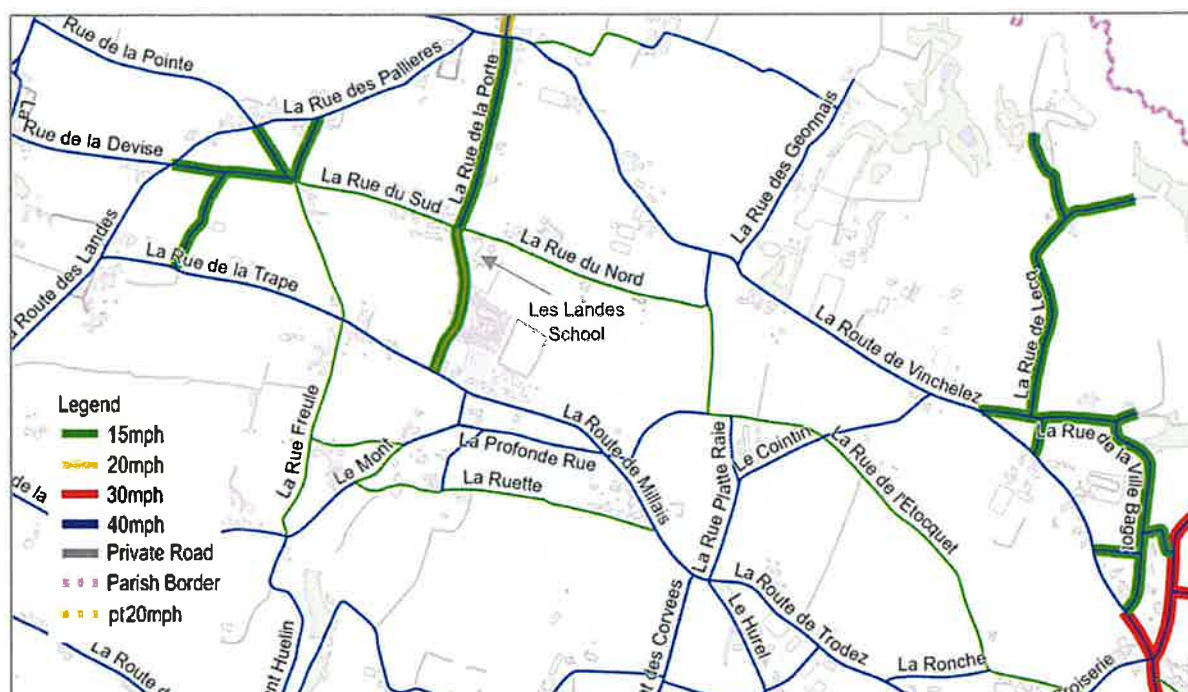

St Ouen's Green lanes



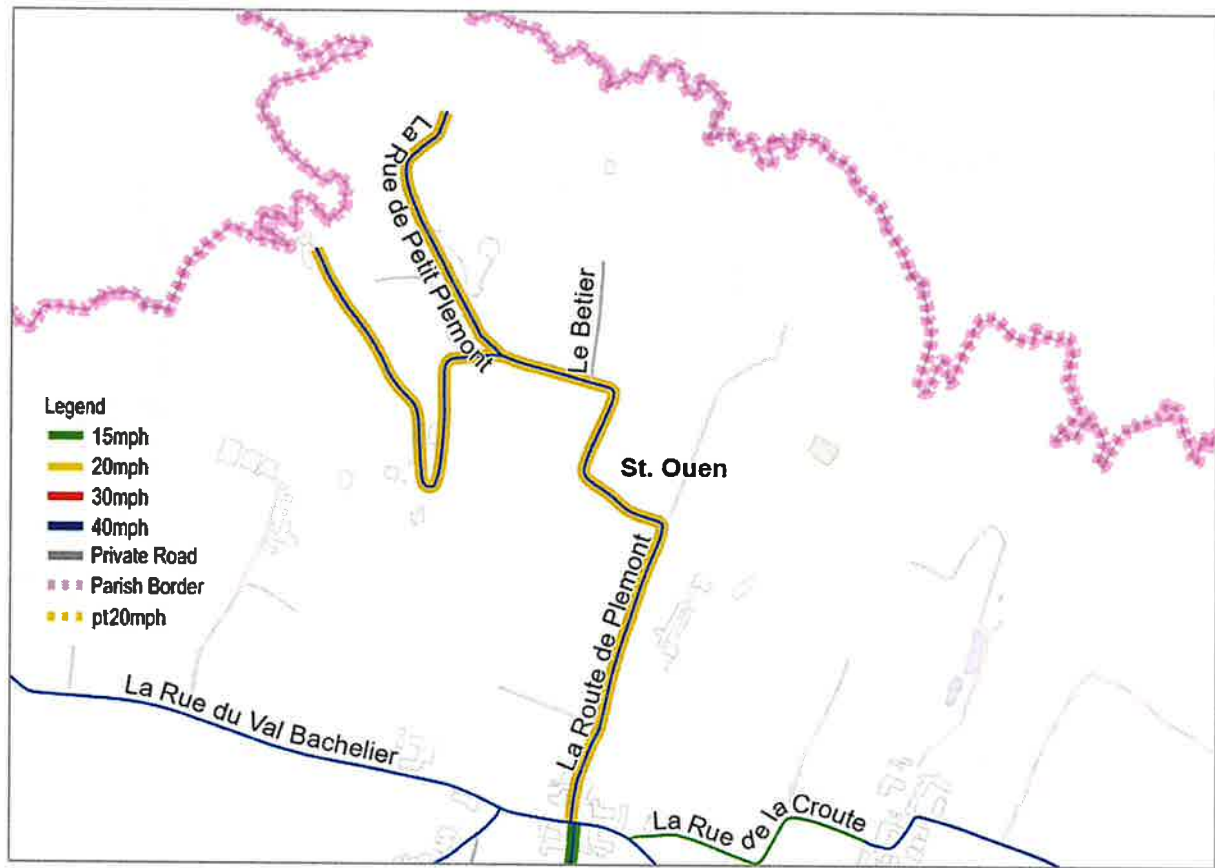

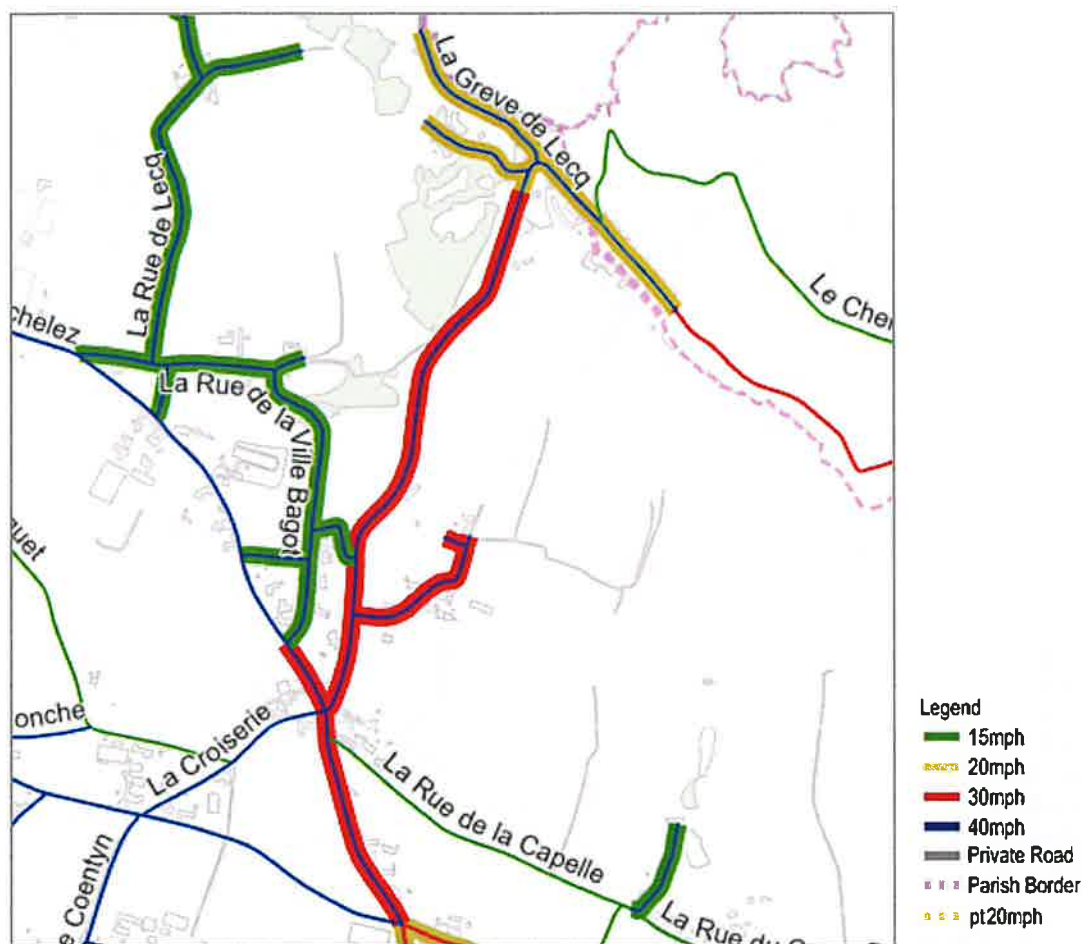

La Greve de Lecq



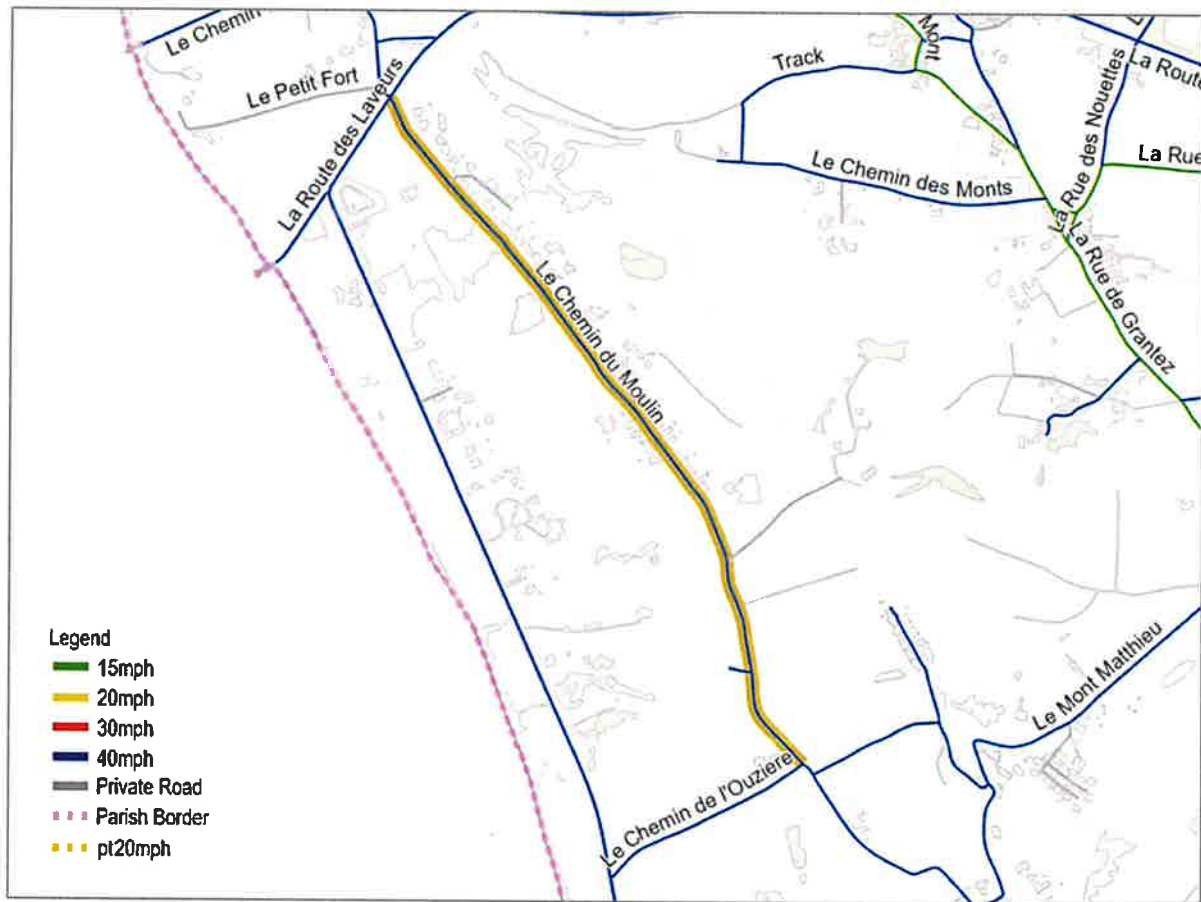
