 [REDACTED] detailed the works that had been carried out for the benefit of the Committee. He advised that new foundations had been built, drainage has been installed, and further support is provided by soil. He added that, behind the stones in the wall that appear loose, there is concrete, which stabilises the wall. The Committee considered the work to have been carried out to a high standard and were satisfied with the reparations.

On the matter of the erosion of the road, [REDACTED] asked for the tarmac fillet to be extended to the land boundary. He explained that the damage in the road appeared where there was a drain underneath. The cracks were letting in water, which is causing erosion and subsidence. After some discussion, the Committee agreed to extend the tarmac fillet, and to excavate the damaged section of road and repair with patching.

The Connétable directed the Parish Secretary Designate to make the necessary arrangements to obtain quotes for the work.
