AT AN ASSEMBLY of Principles and Electors of the Parish of St. Ouen, duly convened and held in St. Ouen's Parish Hall on Wednesday, 30 April, 2025 at 7pm to:-

- 1. Receive, and if deemed advisable, approve the Act of the Parish Assembly held on 11, December 2024.
- 2. To elect a Vingtenier for Grande Cueilette.

Connétable Richard Honeycombe opened the meeting by welcoming everyone in attendance, and asked the Parish Secretary Designate to read the convening notice.

Apologies were received from Advocate Richard Michel, member of the Roads Committee, and Reverand Ian Pallent, Rector.
