AT AN ASSEMBLY of Electors of the Parish of St. Ouen, duly convened and held in St. Ouen's Parish Hall on Wednesday, 21 May, 2025 at 7.00p.m. pursuant to an Act of the Royal Court dated 25 April, 2025, whereby it was ordered that an election be held for Centenier in the Parish of St. Ouen.

Mr Wayne Allan Pipon du Feu, of Fourwinds Cottage, Le Chemin de L'Ouzeire, St. Ouen was nominated on the proposition of Mrs Teresa Surcouf. The seconders were Anthony Markey, Peter Surcouf, Simon Surcouf, Paul Jacklin, Trevor de la Haye, Richard Le Cornu, Zoe Le Cornu, Clive Murphy and Sharon Wright.

Upon proposing Mr du Feu, Mrs Surcouf said he had served 8 years in a variety of roles in the Honorary Police, including Constable's Officer and Vingtenier, prior to being elected as Centenier in 2022. He has worked as an engineer at Jersey Telecoms and currently plies his trade with CI Fire and Securities. She added that Mr du Feu is calm and patient with the public, and a dedicated and popular member of the Honorary Police.

The Assembly, having lasted the statutory time and there being no further nominations, the President declared Mr Wayne Allan Pipon du Feu duly elected as Centenier.

Having congratulated Mr du Feu on his election, the President thanked him for his previous honorary service to the Parish of St. Ouen, and advised that Jurat Michael Powell would be making contact to warn him to attend the Royal Court to take the Oath of Office on a date to be confirmed.

Mr du Feu thanked his proposer and seconders.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting closed at 7.11p.m.
