

**AN ASSEMBLY** of Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Ouen was duly held in the upstairs Committee Rooms at St Ouen's Parish Hall on Wednesday 10 December 2025 at 7.00pm to:-

1. Receive and if deemed advisable, approve the Act of the Parish Assembly held on 23 July 2025
2. Elect a Constable's Officer for Petite Cueillette
3. Elect a Constable's Officer for Cueillette de Grantez
4. Elect a Constable's Officer for Cueillette de Millais
5. Elect a Constable's Officer for Cueillette de Vinchelez
6. Elect a Constable's Officer for Cueillette de Leoville

The Connétable welcomed those present and offered apologies from Vingtenier Charlotte Pinchard, Centenier Wayne du Feu and Vingtenier Robert Brown.

The Connétable then asked the Parish Secretary to read the convening notice.
