AT AN ASSEMBLY of Electors of the Parish of St. Ouen, duly convened and held in St. Ouen's Parish Hall on Wednesday, 28 January, 2026 at 7.10p.m. pursuant to an Act of the Royal Court dated 9 January, 2026, whereby it was ordered that an election be held for Centenier in the Parish of St. Ouen.

Apologies were received from Centenier Robert Hall, Advocate Richard John Michel (member of the Roads Committee), Basil George Carre, Nigel Hall (Chairman of the Rates Assessment Committee), David Sharp (member of the Rates Assessment Committee), Mark Grigg (member of the Rates Assessment Committee), Paul James (member of the Rates Assessment Committee), Richard Renouf and Julie Journeaux.

Mr Bernard Peter Connor BEM, of 11 Le Clos de Mahaut, La Rue des Marettes, St. Ouen was nominated on the proposition of Mr. Brian Follain. The seconders were Martin Le Maistre, Basil Carre, Claire Le Brocq, Jennifer Le Mains, Lorna Corfield, Roger Corfield, June Beresford, William Beresford and Pamela Follain.

Upon proposing Centenier Connor, Mr Brian Follain informed the meeting that Centenier Connor had served 22 years in the army, before returning to the island and joining the Honorary Police in the Parish of St Saviour. He served as CO, Vingtenier, Centenier and Chef de Police, before moving to St Ouen and joining the Honorary Police. In 1993 he was awarded the British Empire Medal.

The Assembly having lasted the statutory time and there being no further nominations the President declared Centenier Bernard Connor duly elected as Centenier.

Having congratulated Centenier Connor on his election, the President thanked him for his previous honorary service to the Parish of St. Ouen, and advised that Jurat Averty would be in contact to warn him for his appearance in the Royal Court to take the Oath of Office on 13 March 2026.

Centenier Connor thanked his proposer and seconders, as well as his colleagues currently serving on the St Ouen Honorary Police.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting closed at 7.28p.m.
