Minutes:

1. The Committee attended the pathway and noted a fenced section that had been constructed on a brick base between two original pillars, at the southern end of the path. Discussion was had over whether the fence was encroaching on to the land. There is a garden belonging to a nearby property on the other side of the fence. It was judged to be encroaching over the border of the property.

Whilst walking the path, the Committee discussed whether ownership of the path belonged to the Parish or the Rectorate. DC was charged with investigating and reporting back to the Committee.

The Committee noted vehicle [REDACTED] parked at the entrance of the pathway at the southern end. It was noted that the vehicle owner did not have permission to park there and it was causing an obstruction. The Committee directed DC to contact the registered keeper and to arrange for its removal.

Following the site visit, the Committee drew the following conclusions:

- a. that ownership needs to be confirmed
- b. establish if the property with the erected fencing had encroached

- c. if the pathway is under the ownership of the Parish, then it needs to be levelled and made safe and accessible. A top layer of chippings should be laid making it more efficient to manage the weeds.
