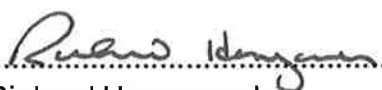

Minutes:

The Committee met further to a site visit of 19 May 2026, to discuss the parking issues at La Ville de la Croix.

The Connétable advised he had received further complaints in relation to inconsiderate parking on the estate. As noted in the minutes of the meeting held on 19 May, there were concerns regarding access for emergency vehicles. RH advised the meeting that these concerns had been realised following a recent visit of the emergency services to the estate, who found their access to a property blocked. This factor was considered by the Committee to be extremely concerning. RH added that he had approached a highways consultant at the DFI and he had received advice that Clearway signage was the most appropriate on this occasion. This will help to avoid urbanisation of the area, which yellow line markings would result in.

Following further discussion around the table, the Committee unanimously decided to bring the matter forward and to apply the parking restrictions. Consequently, they directed the Parish Secretary to write to all residents, and owners where different, and advise accordingly. The Secretary was also directed to make the necessary arrangements for signage and markings.
